Your blessed journey begins as you depart from John F. Kennedy International Airport (JFK) or Washington Dulles International Airport (IAD) for Amman, Jordan.



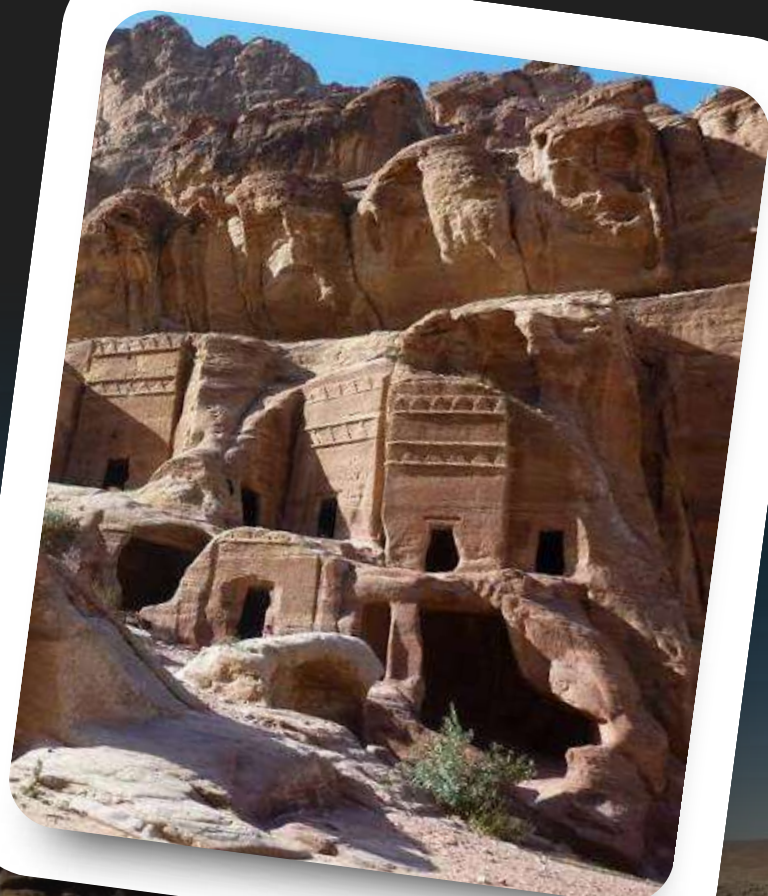
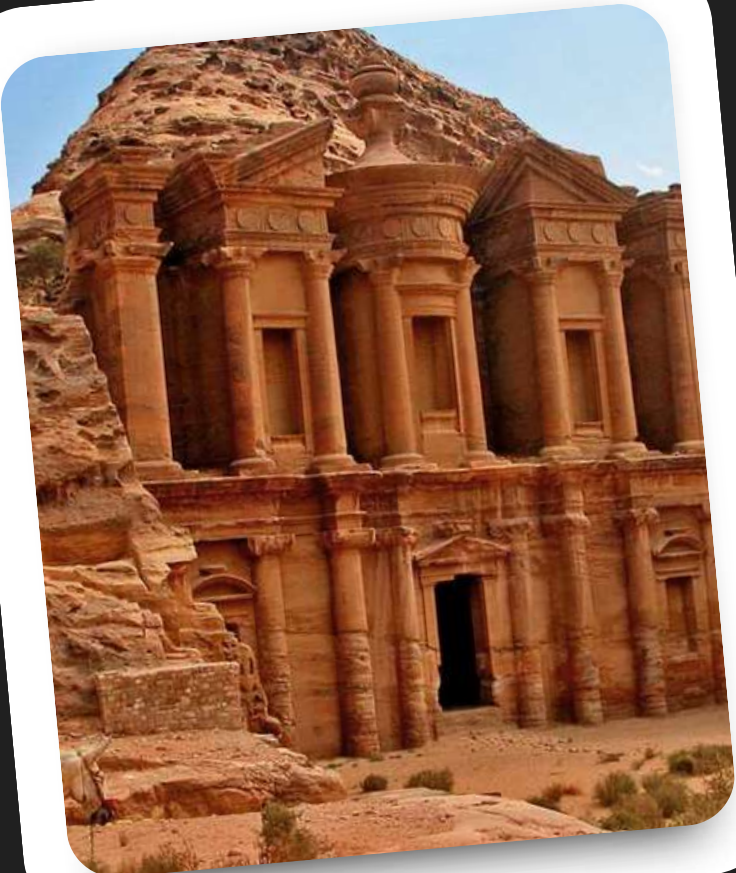
WELCOME TO JORDAN

Upon arrival at Queen Alia International Airport in Amman, complete immigration and customs before being warmly welcomed by our local representatives.

Transfer to your hotel for check-in and refreshment.

The remainder of the day is yours to relax after your international journey and prepare for the remarkable experiences that await over the coming days.





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JORDAN'S ISLAMIC HERITAGE & THE ROSE CITY OF PETRA

DAY 3 – MONDAY, NOVEMBER 23

After breakfast, your exploration of Jordan begins with a visit to Ashabul Kahf (The Cave of the Seven Sleepers), a site connected to the inspiring account mentioned in Surah Al-Kahf, reminding believers of steadfast faith and Allah's divine protection.



Continue to the magnificent King Hussein Mosque, Jordan's largest mosque, before visiting Maqam Abdulrahman bin Awf (RA), one of the ten companions of Prophet Muhammad ﷺ who were promised Paradise.

Later, journey south to the breathtaking city of Petra, one of the New Seven Wonders of the World and a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Hidden within towering rose-red mountains, Petra showcases extraordinary architecture carved directly into stone more than two thousand years ago by the Nabataean civilization.

Return to Amman for your overnight stay.



FOLLOWING THE FOOTSTEPS OF HISTORY

DAY 4 – TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 24

Today's journey continues with visits to two of Jordan's most cherished Islamic landmarks.

Begin at the Cave of the Seven Sleepers, where the story of the believing youths continues to inspire generations with lessons of patience and unwavering faith.

Continue to the Blessed Tree, believed to be the tree beneath which the young Prophet Muhammad ﷺ rested during his journey to Syria. According to Islamic tradition, it was here that the monk Bahira recognized signs of the Prophet's future mission.

Return to Amman for dinner and your final overnight stay before crossing into the Holy Land.



JOURNEY INTO THE BLESSED LAND

DAY 5 – WEDNESDAY, NOVEMBER 25

After breakfast, depart Jordan and travel to Allenby Bridge, where our team will assist you through all border formalities before entering Palestine.

Your first destination is Jericho, one of the world's oldest inhabited cities. Visit the Mount of Temptation, overlooking the Jordan Valley, before continuing to Maqam Nabi Musa (AS), a site traditionally associated with Prophet Musa (AS).

By evening, arrive in the blessed city of Jerusalem (Al-Quds), a city beloved by generations of Prophets and home to Islam's first Qiblah.



DISCOVERING THE BLESSED CITY OF AL-QUDS

DAY 6 – THURSDAY, NOVEMBER 26

Today is dedicated to exploring the spiritual heart of Jerusalem.

Walk through the ancient streets of the Old City as you visit the blessed Masjid Al-Aqsa, the first Qiblah of Islam and the site of the miraculous Isra and Mi'raj.

Continue to the iconic Dome of the Rock, one of the world's most recognizable Islamic landmarks, before wandering through Jerusalem's historic souqs and centuries-old streets that have welcomed pilgrims for generations.

Return to your hotel for dinner and overnight.

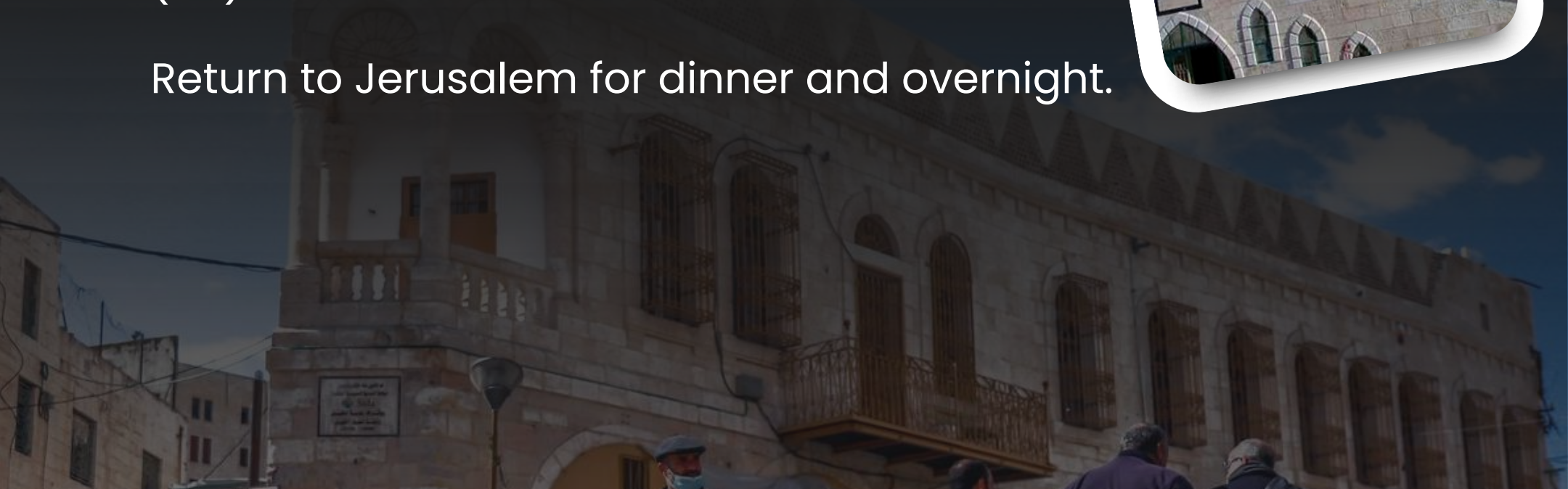
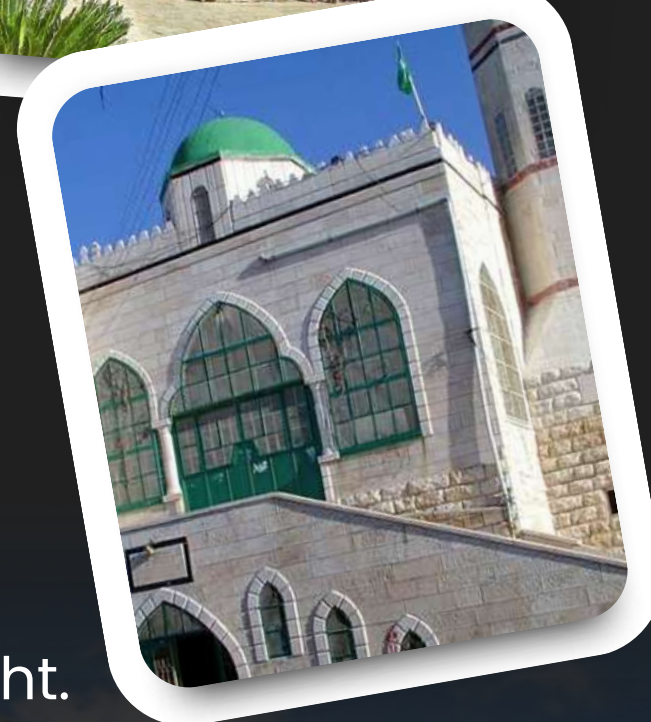
HEBRON, THE CITY OF PROPHET IBRAHIM (AS)

DAY 8 – SATURDAY, NOVEMBER 28

Following breakfast, enjoy panoramic views of Jerusalem from the Mount of Olives before visiting the resting places of Rabia Al-Adawiyya (RA) and Salman Al-Farsi (RA).

Continue to Hebron (Al-Khalil), one of the oldest cities in the world and home to the revered Ibrahimi Mosque. Here you'll visit the resting places of Prophet Ibrahim (AS), Prophet Ishaq (AS), Prophet Yaqub (AS) and their families before stopping at Maqam Nabi Yunus (AS) in Halhul.

Return to Jerusalem for dinner and overnight.





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FROM AL-QUDS TO THE CITY OF THE PROPHET ﷺ

DAY 9 – SUNDAY, NOVEMBER 29

After breakfast, bid farewell to Jerusalem as you return through Allenby Bridge and travel to Amman Airport for your onward flight to Madinah Al-Munawwarah.

As your aircraft approaches the illuminated city of the Prophet ﷺ, your pilgrimage enters its most spiritually uplifting chapter.

Upon arrival at Prince Mohammad bin Abdulaziz International Airport, guests will collect their luggage and proceed to the arrivals hall. Immigration procedures will already have been completed.

You will be warmly welcomed by the professional staff of Sara International Travel and Travel Gate USA and escorted directly to your hotel.

Accommodation will be at the prestigious Elaf Taiba Hotel, one of the finest luxury hotels located adjacent to Masjid An-Nabawi.

After check-in, guests will receive a brief orientation of the hotel and surrounding area before enjoying a period of rest. In the evening, guests may perform their first salah in Masjid an-Nabawi and begin enjoying the blessings of Madinah Al-Munawwarah.

DAY 10 – MONDAY, NOVEMBER 30

Today guests will enjoy a guided walking tour around the blessed surroundings of Masjid an-Nabawi. The tour will include:

- The area surrounding the Green Dome (Qubbatul Khadra)
- Conveying salaams upon Rasulullah ﷺ
- Masjid Abu Bakr As-Siddiqؓ
- Masjid Umar ibn Al-Khattabؓ
- As-Safiyyah Park and Museum
- Historical sites surrounding Masjid an-Nabawi

As part of your stay in Madinah Al-Munawwarah, Sara International Travel and Travelgate USA will arrange, subject to availability and the regulations of the authorities, permits for guests to visit and pray in the blessed Rawdah Ash-Sharifah.

The Prophet ﷺ said:

"The space between my house and my minbar is one of the gardens from among the gardens of Paradise." Pilgrims will be guided regarding their scheduled appointment and the proper etiquette of visiting the Rawdah.

We pray that Allah grants every pilgrim the opportunity to offer salah and make du'a in this blessed garden from the gardens of Jannah.

The remainder of the day may be spent in worship, Qur'an recitation, and personal reflection.

DAY 11 – TUESDAY, DECEMBER 1

Masjid Quba

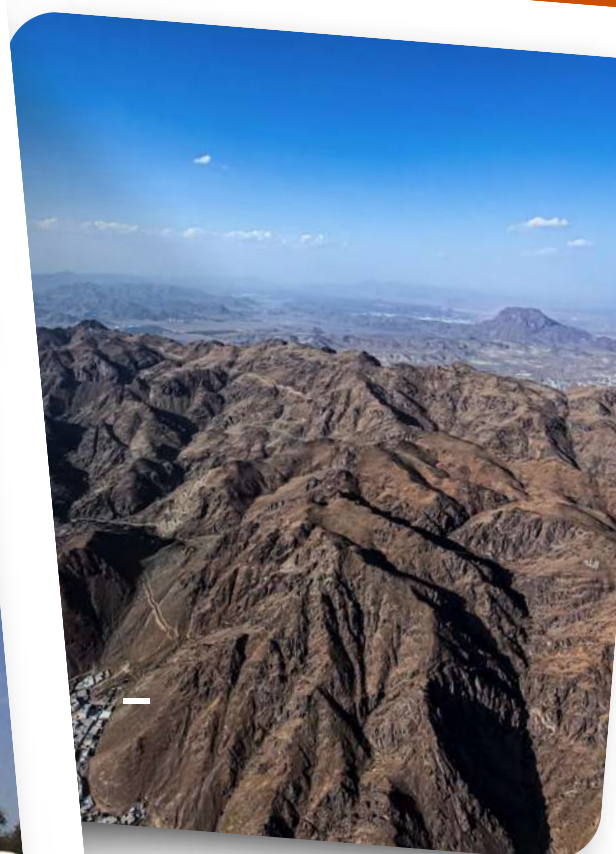
Today is dedicated to visiting the historical and spiritual landmarks of Madinah Al-Munawwarah.

Visits will include:

- Masjid Quba
- Masjid Qiblatain
- Saba Masajid (The Seven Mosques)
- Site of the Battle of Khandaq
- Jabal Uhud
- The resting place of Sayyiduna Hamzah[ؓ] and the martyrs of Uhud
- The Seerah Museum



At Masjid Quba, pilgrims will perform two rak'ah and be reminded of the virtue mentioned by Rasulullah ﷺ:
"Whoever performs wudu in his residence and then comes to Masjid Quba and prays two rak'ah therein will receive the reward of an Umrah."





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MADINAH → MAKKAH TRANSITION

DAY 12 – WEDNESDAY, DECEMBER 2

Following Salat al-Dhuhr, guests will depart Madinah via the Haramain High-Speed Train.

Pilgrims will enter into the state of Ihram prior to departure. The journey to Makkah takes approximately two hours and ten minutes.

Upon arrival, guests will be received by the staff of Sara International Travel and Travelgate USA and escorted to:

Rotana Jabal Omar Hotel

A luxurious five-star property located within walking distance of Masjid al-Haram.

After check-in and a brief rest, guests will proceed to Masjid al-Haram accompanied by a resident Imam of Makkah.

The Umrah will include:

- First sight of the Holy Ka'bah
- Tawaf
- Two Rak'ah after Tawaf
- Zamzam water
- Sa'i between Safa and Marwah
- Halq or Taqsir

May Allah accept your Umrah as Umrah Maqboolah. Ameen.





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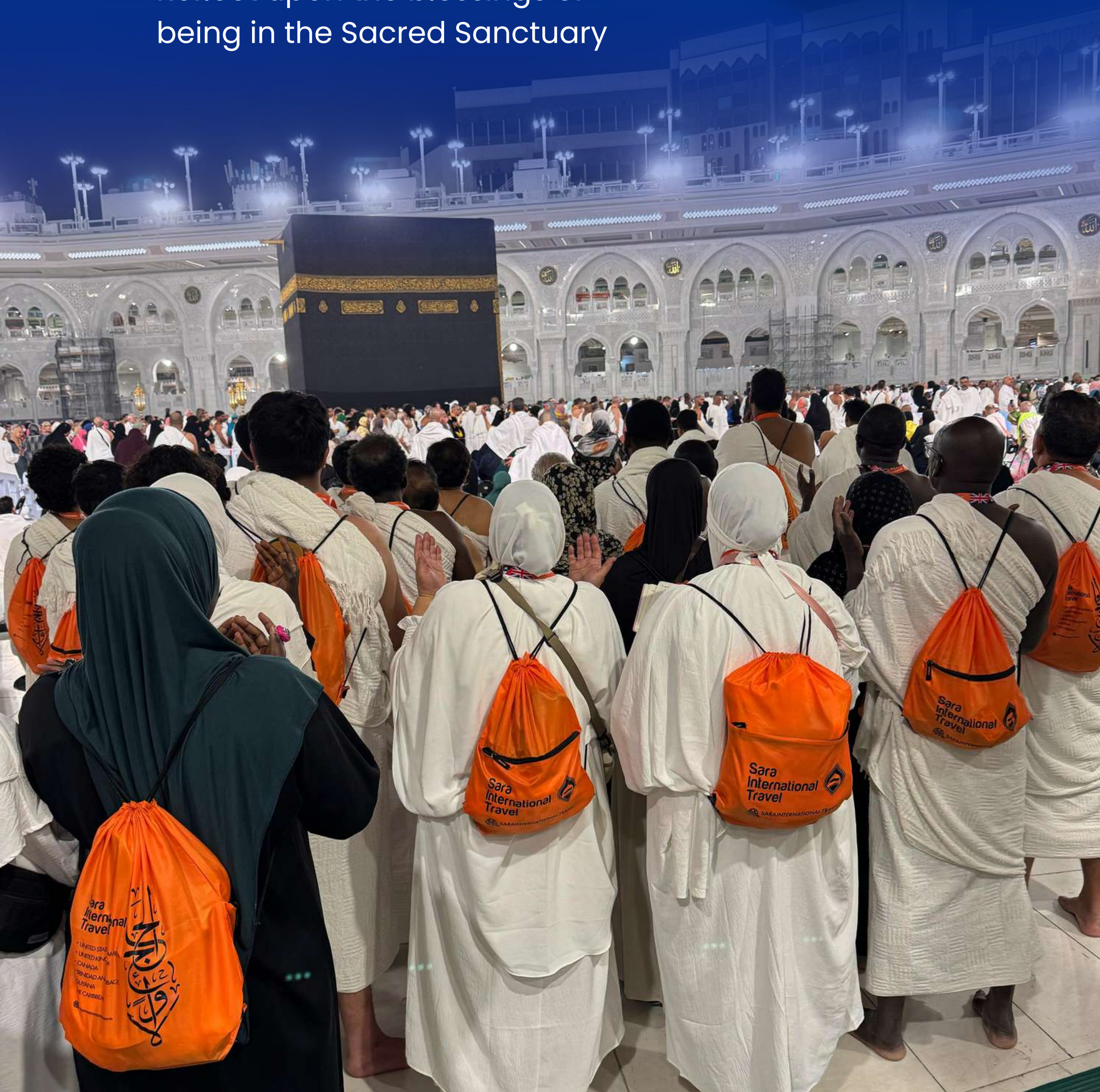
WORSHIP IN MAKKAH AL-MUKARRAMAH
